96%	I learn the importance of the traditions of our faith such as scripture reading, liturgies, sacraments, and celebrations.


98% Catholic viewpoints and connections are integrated into my school subjects and activities.


96% I learn that we all need to play a part in helping make our world a better place for everyone.
